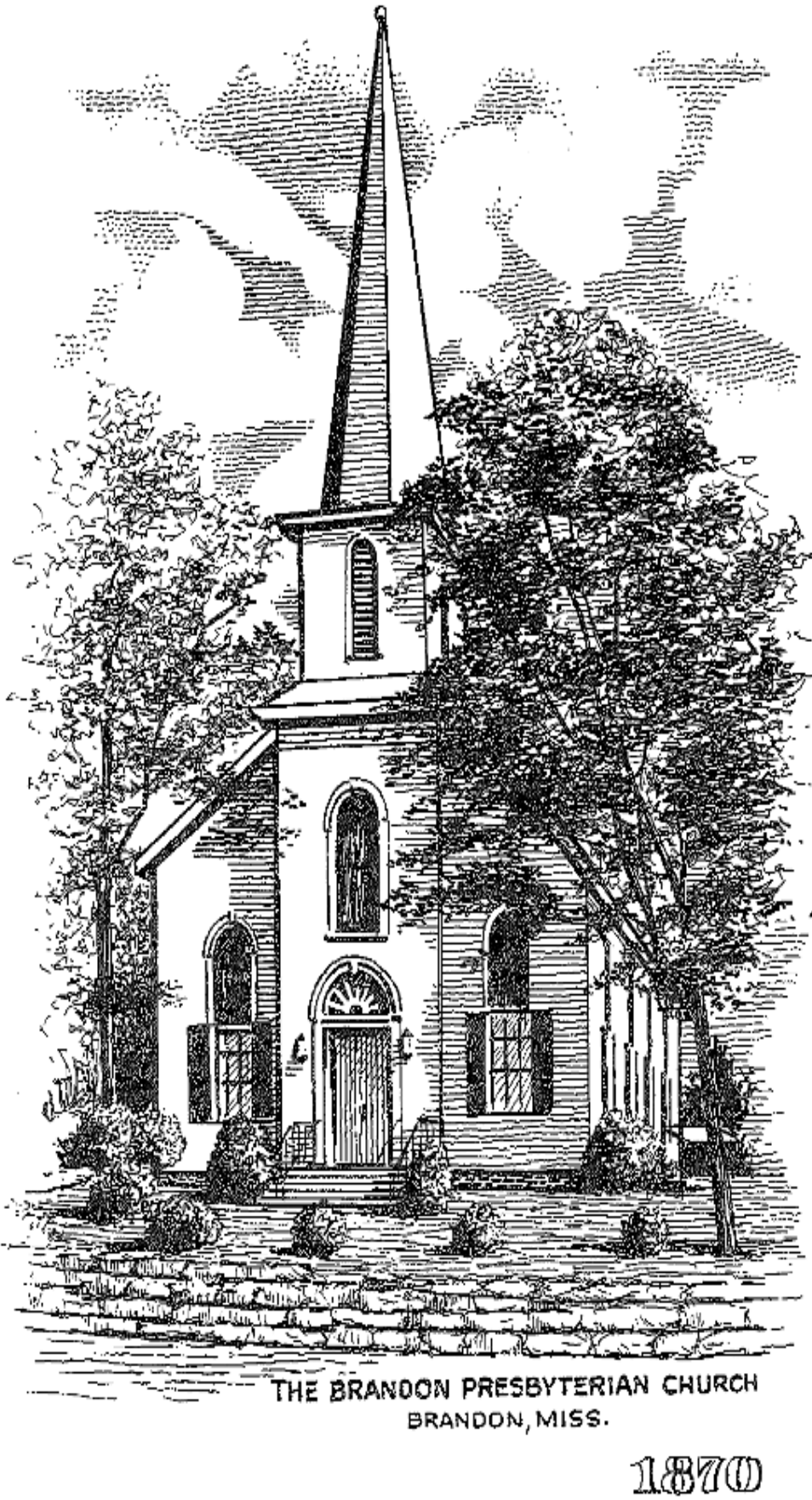
To Our Visitors
