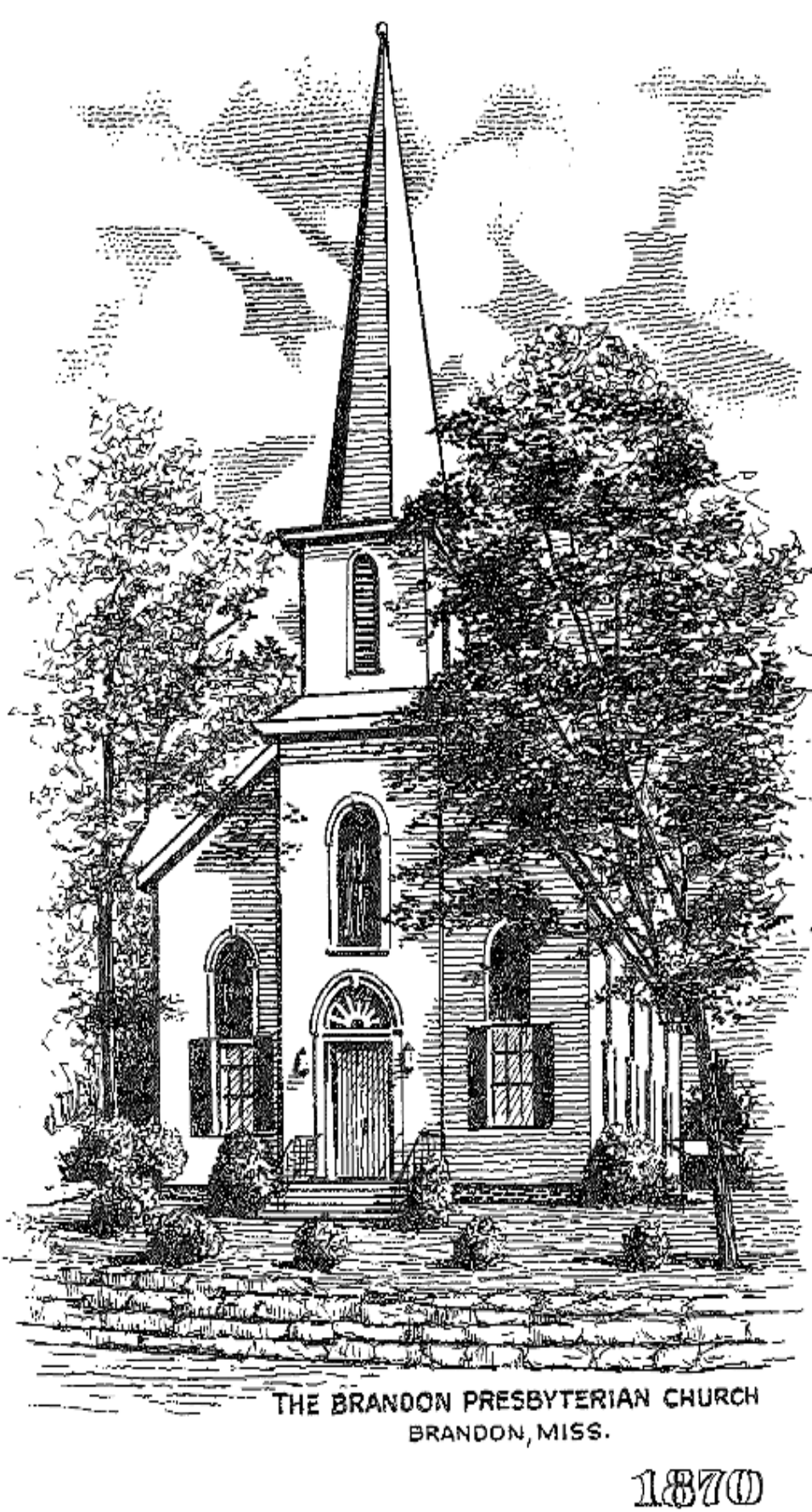

The Nicene Creed
